Proposed Development:

Permission to provide a temporary 'Events Area'. The proposed 'events area' will host a series of temporary uses such as an ice rink with play areas, santas grotto, craft and antique fairs, exhibitions, community events, sporting activities etc. in area of 4187 sq.m. located to the west of the existing centre. This area would be accessed by pedestrians via existing west entrance of the centre and off Charles Place via existing walkway along western side of the centre. The use is for a temporary from 18th June 2009 until 31st January 2010. Temporary marquee structures and facilities will be erected as required for the holding of the events but there will be not permanent works to site area. This site comprises part of the Phase 2 development area, granted permission under Reg. Ref. F08A/0431.
